

Public Hearing
May 1, 2017

The New Castle City Commission held a public hearing on Monday, May 1, 2017 at 6:45pm for the purpose of obtaining the public's comments regarding the proposed 2017/2018 fiscal budget and the expenditures of Road Aid Funds and LGAEF. Present were Mayor Benham, Commissioner Thompson and Kurtz and City Clerk Lynn Adams, Public Works Director Scot Treece, Melissa Blankenship of Landmark Newspapers, Jeff Thoke, Richard and Dani Jaehnigen and citizens Danny Holcomb and Dale Mahoney, Magistrate Terri Cummings and City Attorney Joe Yates.

A quorum was not met until 6:55pm therefore the hearing was called to order later than intended.

No written comments were received prior to the hearing.
