SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE REGARDING FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION

This summary of ordinance is prepared by Joshua E. Clubb, Attorney for the City of New Castle, Kentucky:

Be it hereby ordained by the City Commission of New Castle, Kentucky, that an ordinance is hereby adopted that provides for the regulation of Flood Damage Prevention, including definitions for the ordinance designation of land subject to the ordinance, establishment of a permit process, standards for base flood elevation and standards for subdivision proposals, and appeals and variances. All inconsistent ordinances are hereby repealed.

Said Ordinance also provides for penalties as follows:

Violation of the provisions of this ordinance or failure to comply with any of its requirements, including violation of conditions and safeguards established in connection with granting of a variance or special exceptions, shall constitute a misdemeanor civil offense. Any person who violates this ordinance or fails to comply with any of its requirements shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined no less than \$100 or imprisoned for not more than ten (10) days, or both, and in addition, shall pay all costs and expenses involved in the case. Each day such violation continues shall be considered a separate offense. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the Floodplain Administrator from taking such other lawful action as is necessary to prevent or remedy any violation.
