

January 10, 2022

The New Castle City Commission meeting was held on Monday, January 10, 2022 at 6pm. Present was Mayor Kurtz and Commissioners Thompson, Sevier and Hay. Also present was City Clerk Lynn Adams, Public Works Director Joey Bramblett, Asst. Director Vincent Bates and Sabrina Doll from the NCVFD. Citizens present were Dale Mahoney and Danny Holcomb.

Mayor Kurtz called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Sevier made the motion to accept the minutes from all December meetings as presented. Commissioner Hay seconded the motion. The motion did carry unanimously.

Commissioner Sevier made the motion to approve all disbursements, deposits and transfers for the month of December. Commissioner Hay seconded the motion. It carried unanimously.

Commissioner Thompson checked all bank balances using the online service.

Deputy Jamial could not be present as he was working EMS in Owen Co. He will deliver the report to the clerk at a later date.

Joey advised that one of the two snow plows is toast, it is 22 years old and a new one is needed. He is securing prices.

Sabrina gave the 2021 annual report for the fire department. 26 runs were made within the city for various reasons (fires, EMS assists, wrecks, etc.) and 70 were made outside city limits in the county.

There was discussion as to whether the City wanted to have a festival this year. It was decided to start preliminary planning for a city festival to be held on the 2nd Saturday in June.

It was reported that the burned out house on Carter street has finally been removed.

As there was no further business to be addressed, Commission Thompson made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Sevier seconded and the motion carried unanimously.
