

ORDINANCE #20-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE, KENTUCKY AMENDING
CERTAIN WATER AND SEWER BILLING PROCEDURES

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of New Castle, Kentucky that §51.167 (D) of the New Castle code of Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

The water and sewer rates or charges shall be billed monthly on statements which shall be issued on or about the first of each month and all bills for such service shall be considered due and payable fifteen days after the date of issue. If a bill is not paid within fifteen days after such date of issue the bill shall be considered delinquent and there shall be imposed a penalty on each bill not so paid in an amount equal to 10% of the charges (other than sales tax) shown on the face amount of the delinquent bill. The City shall serve a customer written notice of his/her delinquency and of the fact that the customer is entitled, upon written request, to a hearing on the question of termination of service. If the bill is not paid within ten days after the mailing of the notice and if no hearing is requested or if a hearing is requested and timely held and such customer's delinquency is thereby established, the City may disconnect the water service of the customer without further notice. If water service is disconnected by the City by reason of delinquency in the payment of any water, sewer bills, reconnection of such service shall not be made until the owner or user pays all charges and penalties owed plus the amount of ~~\$25.00~~ \$40.00 as a disconnection and reconnection charge. If any deadline date falls on a Sunday or legal holiday, such deadline shall not expire until the next secular day thereafter.
