

ORDINANCE #16-07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW CASTLE, KENTUCKY ADDING CERTAIN CONDITIONS TO THE DEFINITIONS TO PLUMBING HAZARDS UNDER CHAPTER 132 (UNSAFE HOUSING) AND ESTABLISHING RESPONSIBILITY FOR CHARGES WHILE STRUCTURE IS OCCUPIED.

Be it hereby ordained by the City Commission of the City of New Castle, Kentucky as follows:

Section 132.02 (G)(1) of the City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

§132.02(G)(1) Any structure which has plumbing that permits contamination of water supply through backflow, back siphonage, or any other method of contamination "or any structure that continues to be occupied after violation of §§ 51.185."

Section 132.02(G)(1) of the City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

§51.185(C) Any discontinuance of service to any structure that remains occupied for a period of twenty-four (24) hours after the discontinuation of service shall subject the owner/occupant thereof to the penalty provisions of §51.999(B). In the event that a business is operating in such structure, said disconnection shall constitute an immediate revocation of its business license and subject the licensee to the penalty provisions of §70.99 of the Code. (Ord. 09-09 amended 01/4/2010). If any structure remains occupied then the owner of the property shall be charged for the minimum water, sewer and trash fee for each month of occupancy. (Ord. 16-07).
